Use prompts to write a structured text-based letter of apology using appropriate tone and vocabulary.
	A Report, An Interview & An Account	Write a structured text-based report using the 'where... what...' prompts Use prompts to write a text-based interview producing Qs and responses Write an account of someone who makes a wrong judgement, including explanations and consequences.
